Mariachiara Tallacchini is Professor of Legal Philosophy at the Law Faculty of the University of Piacenza and of Bioethics at the Faculty of Biotechnology of the University of Milan (Italy). She has been (2001-2002) a postdoctoral fellow, under a grant from the National Science Foundation, at the Kennedy School of Government (Harvard University). She has chaired the European Advisory Group on Science in Society for FP7 between 2006 and 2008, and is a member of several scientific and ethics committees in the fields of research ethics, animal and food ethics, genetics, environmental protection. Her interests concern the legal regulation of science and technology in the field of life sciences, the patentability of biotechnological inventions, the issues of scientific uncertainty and the law, the relationships between science and democracy.
